A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE TOWN OF EATONVILLE COMMUNITY REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY (TOECRA) APPROVING THE MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING WITH THE ASSOCIATION TO PRESERVE THE EATONVILLE COMMUNITY, INC., PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS, SEVERABILITY, AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS the members of the Board of Directors are the governing body of the agency; and

WHEREAS such members constitute the head of a legal entity, separate, distinct, and independent from the governing body of the County or Municipality; and

WHEREAS the Board of Directors wishes to enter partnership with a valued community stakeholder from the Governing body of the County or Municipality; and

WHEREAS the Board of Directors acknowledges P.E.C. has expertise in the are of Cultural Heritage Tourism which serves as a catalyst for economic development.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN OF EATONVILLE COMMUNITY REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY OF EATONVILLE, FLORIDA

SECTION ONE: FINDINGS: The recitals set forth above are hereby acknowledged and accepted by the Eatonville Community Redevelopment Agency as findings made by the Board of Directors and does hereby incorporate such recitals as findings into this Resolution.

SECTION TWO: AFFIRMATION: The Board of Directors of the Eatonville Community Redevelopment Agency does hereby affirm its findings in the CRA Plan and Chapter 163, Florida Statute as provided.

SECTION THREE: ADOPTION OF MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING: The Town of Eatonville Community Redevelopment Agency and the Board of Directors do hereby adopt the Memorandum of Understanding with P.E.C. and authorizes the execution of said agreement by the Chairman, Legal and/or Executive Director as needed.


