

CRA RESOLUTION #2017-11

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF EATONVILLE COMMUNITY REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY ADOPTING FISCAL YEAR 2017-2018 CRA BUDGET, PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS, SEVERABILITY, AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the members of the government body shall be the members of the agency; and

WHEREAS, such members constitute the head of a legal entity, separate, distinct, and independent from the governing body of the county or municipality; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors are required to adopt an annual spending plan consistent with its CRA Plan and operations of the agency.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN OF EATONVILLE COMMUNITY REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY OF EATONVILLE, FLORIDA.

SECTION ONE: **FINDINGS:** the recitals set forth above are hereby acknowledge and accepted by the Eatonville Community Redevelopment Agency as findings made by the Board of Directors and does hereby incorporate such recitals as findings into this Resolution.

SECTION TWO: **AFFIRMATION:** The Board of Directors of the Eatonville Community Redevelopment Agency does hereby affirm its findings in the CRA Plan and the Chapter 163, Florida Statutes as provided.


